#### POLICY DOCUMENT GOVERNING VENUS INTERNATIONAL WOMEN AWARDS

#### 1. Preamble

The Venus International Women Awards (VIWA) scheme was instituted in the year 2016 by the Centre for Advanced Research and Design (CARD) of Venus International Foundation (VIF), are presented yearly during the Annual Women's Meet (AWM) that is conducted during March month of the year. The Award scheme has a Criteria, Standards, Policy, Application Form, Expert Committee and Judging Process etc that are governed by the Board of Trust.

Vision : To Celebrate the Achievements of Woman Professionals

Mission : To recognize 'Best - Brightest - Inspirational - Talented Woman

Professionals' who demonstrated courage, creativity and excellence,

in their discipline

Descrives: To honour individuals for the significant contributions in Science and

# 2. Venus International Women Awards (VIWA)

The Venus International Women Awards (Certificate and Memento. It's a Non-financial Award) is a part of the Annual Women's Meet that 'Acknowledges and Celebrates the Achievements of Women Professionals'. It is convened by the CARD of VIF and conducted in accordance with the VIF BOARD MEETING resolutions.

#### 2.1 The VIWA 2020: [F. No. WA20/AN05/AAP-I]

The VIWA 2020 is convened by the CARD of VIF and conducted in accordance with the VIF BOARD MEETING resolution vide F. No. VIF/MIN/BM-V/2019 held on June 27, 2019 at VIF Head Quarters.

# 2.2 General Eligibility:

The Award is applicable for Women Professionals of any nationality in the age group of 24 - 65 years. The applicant must have completed Post Graduate/Doctorate degree (or equivalent) prior to the date of submission of nomination application.

### 3. Disciplines and Categories

The VIWA 2020 invites nominations vide F. No. VIF/CFN/WA/2020 opened on 7 August 2019 from eligible individuals those are in 'Continuous Regular Service in Research or Academic Institution' and working on the frontiers of Science and Technology.

# 3. 2 Category, Criteria and Eligibility

### 3. 2. 1 Lifetime Achievement (Code: L)

This award has been conferred for a remarkable woman professional who demonstrated a track record of academic/research excellence in the field of science and technology that are reflected by the distinct innovations and initiatives. The nominee must be above 55 years of age and at least should have 30 years of service as on June 30, 2019.

#### 3. 2. 2 Distinguished Woman (Code: D)

This award has been conferred for a successful woman professional who made significant contribution in the field of science and technology and has exceptional record of contribution to the institute (demonstrated courage, creativity, excellence, originality and endurance). The nominee must be above 44 years of age and at least should have 20 years of service as on June 30, 2019

# 3. 2. 3 Outstanding Woman (Code: O)

This award has been conferred for a dedicated woman professional working in the field of science and technology and has record of contribution to the institute (demonstrated courage, creativity and originality). The nominee must be above 34 years of age and should have 10 years of service as on June 30, 2019.

# 3. 2. 4 Young Woman (Code: Y)

This award has been conferred for a passionate and courageous woman professional working in the field of science and technology. The nominee must be above 24 years of age and should have 3 years of service as on June 30, 2019

#### 4. Submission and Selection Process

#### 4.1 Submission:

Following are the list of documents to be submitted for nomination

- 4.1.1 The filled application form in a PDF/.Doc/.Docx format
- 4.1.2 Duly completed curriculum vitae (of any template/pages) in a PDF format
- 4.1.3 Passport size photograph (JPEG/PNG format)
- 4.1.4 Copy of Degree certificates (PhD or Equivalent) in a PDF/JPEG/PNG format
- 4.1.5 Copy of the work place ID (PDF/JPEG/PNG format)
- The nomination documents must be submitted electronically to: viwa2020@venusinfo.org (Or) directorvifindia@gmail.com

- Note: The VIWA 2020 no longer requires a hardcopy of the application

#### 4.2 Process:

This section describes the total VIWA 2020 processes in steps.

- Step 1 : Received Nomination documents will be sent for screening process
- Step 2: Acknowledgement intimation via email will be communicated to the Nominee
- Step 3: VIWA team may ask the proof for the credits mentioned in the CV. (Optional)
- Step 4: Cross verifying the documents submitted and forwarding it to the Committee
- Step 5: The selected nominees will be communicated with a formal letter via email
- Step 6: AWM 2020 Registration
- Step 7: Release of the winners list in the official webpage
- Step 8 : Award presentation ceremony
- Step 9: Summary of the AWM 2020 will be floated in the official webpage
- Step 10: Exclusive webpage for award winner profile will be released

# 4.3 Judging Criteria:

The VIWA 2020 judging is a peer review process. The panel (from diverse backgrounds, working individually) is instructed to score entries from 0 to 100, using the criteria. The VIF aggregates the scores to determine each category. The panel decision is final and binding. For each discipline / category (Eg. Distinguished Woman in Science) the expert committee will select 2 Nominees. However the Apex Committee reserve the rights to honour less or more than 2 nominees in any category who meet standards set by the expert committee.

Announcement of Winners : On or before 7 November 2019

Award Presentation : 7 March 2020
